### **RULES**

The Championship Managers reserve the right to adjust the program.

- 1. Suitable footwear must be worn NO SPIKES.
- 2. Competitors must be members of a Zone Team.
- 3. Age: As per age turned during the current year.
  - NB: a) Children are eligible to compete in one event only
    - b) Children must turn 8 in 2023 to be eligible to compete.
- 4. The first 6 placegetters in each event will represent the Association at the NSWPSSA Cross Country Championships to be held at Eastern Creek Sydney Motorsport Park on Friday 21 July 2023. Three Multi Class competitors will be selected in each age category if qualifying times are met.
- 5. Competitors are required to be available to marshal 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event.
- 6. Coaching and pacing during the event is not permitted. Pacing in races by persons not participating in the same race should be warned by the referee. If there is any repetition, the athlete will be disqualified from the event.
- 7. The Multi Class competitors who meet qualifying times may apply to compete at the Sydney East Cross Country Championships.
- 8. Protests must be delivered in writing by the Zone Manager to championship management within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the event.
- Video footage of the events will not be accepted in any protests.
